

How to manage clinical areas




You can view, add, edit and remove a clinical area.

To view clinical areas, navigate to Settings and click Manage clinical areas





> To add a new clinical area, click Add a clinical area



You will be taken to the Create clinical area page. Fill in the details specified to add a clinical area.

- Fields that are followed by a * (star) are required. You will not be able to submit an added clinical area if you do not enter required details.
- Some selections will be drop-down menus, such as Facility.





- •To add a profession/s that can be placed in the clinical area, click Add a profession




You will be taken to a pop-up form.


> To add a profession, choose from the options in the drop-down menu




> Once selected, click Add profession




It will then show it as processing before taking you back to the **Create clinical area** page where you should be able to see that profession added to the list. You can add multiple professions to the same clinical area.



> To remove a profession, click on the down-arrow and select **Remove**






Add a contact

> To add the primary contact details, select a name from drop-down menu




> To add secondary contacts, click Add contact




You will be taken to a pop-up directory.

- > To add the contact, click on the checkbox by the name, then click Add




You will see the related contact name appear in the list







> To remove a related contact, click on the down-arrow and select **Remove**

Key terms

Definition of terms used in this how-to guide:

| Clinical Area Descriptor | A specific type of placement setting. This could be a place e.g. a specific ward, or a team/person. |
|--------------------------|------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| Facility | Facilities are where an organisation provides health services (e.g. a hospital, community pharmacy or out-patient clinic). A facility may contain one or more clinical area (e.g. an Oncology Ward or Physiotherapy Department). Placement offers can be created against these clinical areas. |
| Offer ID | This number can be entered to view specific expressions of interest. |
| | The format of this number is SPO-000000 (e.g., SPO-001043). |
| Placement request | The Education Provider can request a number of placement days on a specific Placement Offer detail for consideration by the Health Provider. The Education Provider makes a request on a Health Provider Placement Offer Detail |
| Profession | This means the area of health the person will be training in. |
| | A non-comprehensive list of Allied, Scientific or Technical Health education programmes that will be included are: Anaesthetic Technicians, Addiction Practitioners, Audiologists, Dieticians, Medical Imaging Technologists, Medical Laboratory Scientists, Occupational Therapists, Oral Health Therapists, Paramedics, Pharmacists, Physiotherapists, Radiation Therapists, Social workers and Speech Language Therapists. |
