Employment:

- Offers of employment will be sent out via email after the ACE notification process is complete
- Positions offered within Te Whatu Ora Waitaha are mostly permanent offers of employment. Some of the primary and community organisations may offer fixed term positions. Most NETP/NESP positions offered are 0.9 – 1.0 FTE
- Start date for NESP and NETP is 27th January (yet to be confirmed).
