# 6-week immunisation event given report guide

### About this document

This guide describes the Power BI 6-week immunisation event given report purpose, and includes an example, data dictionary, known data issues, the filters, ways to sort the report, and information for data analysts.

### Report purpose

The report identifies pēpi who have a recorded outcome on the Aotearoa Immunisation Register (AIR) for one or more of the immunisations on the National Immunisation Schedule (NIS) due at six weeks of age.

It has been designed to support Primary Health Organisations (PHOs) with the reconciliation of funding to their practices for best practice pre-call, recall and completion of 6-week immunisation services for their enrolled populations during the period 1 April 2024 to 30 June 2025.

**Note:** There are known data issues relating to PMS integration with the AIR that are being worked through. This report provides information from the AIR, and PHOs will need to supplement with PMS data from their practices to accurately manage funding distribution to practices for 6-week immunisations given to their enrolled population. Updates will be made to this report to include additional components (see the data dictionary below) in future releases.

#### When used

This report can be used by PHOs and Health New Zealand immunisation teams to track the uptake of 6-week immunisations.


It can be used by PHOs as the base-level information for 6-week immunisations delivered to their enrolled population (including immunisations delivered in settings outside general practice), however will require supplementary data from PHO general practices to ensure any data that is recorded in the PMS, but is not yet in AIR, can be reconciled and respective funding distributed at the end of each quarter.

**Note:** The contractual PHO quarterly reporting will enable PHOs to provide detail on the full distribution of funding to their general practices for 6-week immunisations.

## Example summary



#### Known data issues

- Some PCV13 vaccinations are being incorrectly recorded as PCV10 by some general
  practices using MedTech as their Practice Management System (PMS). These practices
  should record PCV10 as alternative given and then PCV13 as given. However, if this
  process is followed there will be two PCV immunisation events shown in this report and
  only one should be included for the reconciliation of funding.
- Consumers who are currently pre-enrolled (b-coded) or fully enrolled are included.
   Nominated consumers are not included until they are either pre-enrolled or fully enrolled.
- Vaccinations delivered by general practice for unenrolled or previously enrolled consumers are not included.
- Immunisation events with an indication of 6W are included. This means that any events recorded with any other indications will not be shown.
- Delays and errors in the recording and sending of immunisation events to the AIR will impact the records shown on this report.
- A small number of facility names are currently not shown on the report. These facilities are stored in the AIR, and we are working on surfacing the names.

### About this data

#### Sources

- Individuals are sourced from National Enrolment Service (NES) and National Health Index (NHI) registers. The National Enrolment Service provides national enrolment (used by all general practices) and identity data.
- Immunisation data is sourced from the Aotearoa Immunisation Register (AIR), which includes migrated data from the COVID-19 Immunisation Register (CIR) and the National Immunisation Register (NIR).

## Filters applied to data

- Only vaccinations recorded with an indication of '6W' for any of the following vaccine names and codes are included: DTaP-IPV-HepB/Hib 210307, DTaP-IPV 99001, HepB 08, Hib 48, PCV10 260209, PCV13 133 and RV1 119.
- The date administered is filtered from 1 April 2024.
- For PHOs, data is limited to your currently enrolled and pre-enrolled population.
- The underlying data excludes vaccinations with the status of given overseas.
- The underlying data excludes deceased individuals.

#### Disclaimers

- 1. NIR and CIR data migrated during cutover (2 December 2023) may highlight a small number of historical data quality issues.
- 2. AIR data is refreshed overnight and available at the beginning of each day.
