Professional Partnership Assessment

This competence assessment must be completed prior to authorisation as an HPV Screening Kaimahi with the National Cervical Screening Programme (NCSP).

Before the assessment takes place both kaimahi and responsible clinician(s) must have completed the required e-learning modules.

Following completion of the e-learning modules kaimahi and responsible clinicians can do as many supervised screening consultations as they need to be confident to complete the professional partnership assessment.

Once the assessment is completed and all competencies are met, kaimahi and responsible clinicians can complete the professional partnership agreement.

This assessment and agreement form must be submitted to NCSP via the Workforce Request Portal for authorisation.

Once authorised HPV Screening Kaimahi will get a confirmation that they are authorised.

One assessment per kaimahi is required for each organisation they work in, however each responsible clinician must sign the professional partnership agreement.

E.g. Where an HPV Screening Kaimahi works in partnership with more than one clinician within the service.

Kaimahi and clinicians must meet the criteria set out in the National Cervical Screening Programme (NCSP) Competence and Capability framework and adhere to the NCSP Professional Partnership Policy.

Completed assessments should be retained by the employer as a professional partnership record.
